#### Snack and Drink Donations

- > We are looking for donations of individually wrapped snack items such and cookies, crackers, chips, little bites, fruit snack / roll ups.
- > We also provide them with a soda and or bottled water to drink with their snack which again comes from parent donations.
- > You can place any items that you choose to donate in Mr. Fordham's office and the Snack person will keep a reserve of these items and have them pack and ready for our students at the football games and competitions.

## Director / President Update

- > At the April Booster Meeting Mr. Fordham provided a prioritized Wish List
  - ♦ Shako Hats / Plumes / Gauntlets
  - ♦ 2 tenor toms with carriers
  - ◆ PA system for the field
  - **♦** Chime
- ➤ We currently have a surplus of \$7,800.00
- > 2 tenor toms with carriers will cost approx \$3,000.00
- > Amp and speakers can be purchased at cost through Michael Sorenson for approx \$3,000.00.
- > The new speaker system is a huge upgrade and can be used for more than just amplification on the practice field.
- > The floor was opened for discussion. After much discussion a motion was made by Vivian Allen and with a second by Art Yates
- Vote was passed to purchase the proposed tenors with cases and sound system.
- > Purchasing the plumes with the Shakos had been put on hold pending the

insurance determination regarding the stolen sousaphones.

- > The Plumes are estimated to cost \$3,000.00
  - o \$2420 for 110 plumes
  - o \$450 for holer plus shipping
- > With only \$1,800.00 remaining in surplus this will leave a \$1,200.00 deficit that will have to be taken away from somewhere else in the budget.
- > After much discussion a motion was made by Brian Walker to purchase the plumes and holders. This was seconded by Ben Schaeffer.
- > 3 anonymous donations come forward for a total of \$1,200.00.
- > Vote passed to purchase plumes and their holders/ Carrying case.
